Portuguese Man-o-war

Every year, with the arrival of spring, the Azores see the appearance of many Portuguese Man-o-war Jellyfish (Physalia physalis).

What should you do if you are stung by a Portuguese Man-o-war? In case of being stung by a Portuguese Man-o-war it is recommended to wash the wound with salt water and put vinegar. The purpose of vinegar is to help stop the discharge of poison to the body of the affected person.

- Wash off tentacles with sea water or pick off with fingers
- Seek medical help

Do not:

Rinse with fresh water
